

CHRONOLOGY OF ACTIVITIES
2011-2012 United States Senate Youth Program – INDIANA

- June 10, 2011 Application packet posted on Indiana Bar Foundation website (www.inbf.org). Nomination materials include:
- Nomination form
 - Summary of rules
 - Chronology of activities
- October 1, 2011 Deadline for submission of postmarked nomination materials to Director of Civic Education / *We the People* State Coordinator.
- Nomination form bearing principal's signature
 - 350 to 500 word student essay written by the student on typewriter or word processor
 - Student resume
 - Letter of support from principal
- October 13-15, 2011 Judging of nominations and selection of ten finalists by Indiana Bar Foundation, Indiana Department of Education and Indiana Association of School Principals selection teams.
- October 21, 2011 Notification of ten finalists by phone call, letter or fax to principal. Federal Express letter sent to student as well.
- November 5, 2011 Written test and individual interview at Indiana Bar Foundation, Indianapolis. Exam and interviews will only happen on this date.
- 9:00am - 12:00pm: Written exam
 - 12:00pm - 1:00pm: Lunch and free time
 - 1:00pm - 4:00pm: Individual interview with judges
- November 14, 2011 Names of two Delegates and first and second Alternates sent to Hearst Foundation. Delegates and Alternates will not be notified until selectees' packets of information have been verified by Hearst Foundation and the Indiana Bar Foundation is given permission to notify the public.
- Mid-December, 2011 Delegates and Alternates notified by Hearst Foundation
- March 3-10, 2012 United States Senate Youth Program in Washington, D.C.
